

# Prayer Guide

November 15 to December 14, 2019

Jeremiah 33:3 "Call to Me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know."

## November 15 – Vietnam

Pray for the safety of our team and the pastors who are attending Hub-Leader training today. These pastors are completing Phase C today and are planting churches in one of the most hostile and dangerous countries for a Christian to live in today. Pray that they will keep on shining God's light in the "darkness".

## November 16 – Addis Ababa, Ethiopia

We have a meeting with a group of Christian business men in Addis Ababa today. We will be sharing the Harvesters vision with them and the impact that we are making in their country. Pray that the Holy Spirit will move their hearts to get involved with our ministry.

## November 17 – Bamako, Mali

Our group of pastors are receiving their Phase B training in Bamako today. Pray that this group of pastors will reach the lost in this Muslim country. Christians face harsh and terrible persecution; some even get murdered for sharing the Gospel and leading lost souls to Christ.

## November 18 – Guatemala City, Guatemala

From Guatemala City we serve El Salvador, Belize, Honduras, Costa Rica, Nicaragua and even Mexico - more than 180 million souls! Our pastors are completing their final phase of Harvesters training in Guatemala City today. One of our pastors has led more than 750 souls to Christ in the past 18 months. Pray that all of these pastors will follow his example.

## November 19 – Addis Ababa, Ethiopia

Our group of pastors are completing their Phase B training in Addis Ababa today. The harvest is ready in the Horn of Africa and it is our work to train up enough laborers to lead souls to Christ. Pray with us that these pastors will plant viable churches in communities all over Ethiopia.

## November 20 – Cambodia

Lost souls in Cambodia need to hear the Gospel urgently. Our pastors in Cambodia are completing their Phase C training with Harvesters. These pastors need our urgent and fervent prayers. The need is great in this country where more than 97% of the population are Buddhist.

## November 21 – Kumasi, Ghana

Keep our pastors in Kumasi in your prayers as they complete their Phase B training today. Pray for travel mercies for our Harvesters team as well as the pastors who are attending the

training; some of these pastors have to travel for many days to attend.

## November 22 – USA

According to the latest statistics there is at least one mass shooting that takes place in the USA per day. Let us stand together in prayer for this beautiful nation today. Pray for these troubled souls who are guilty of shooting. Pray that the Holy Spirit will work in their hearts and others as the Gospel is presented.

## November 23 – China

The Chinese government is becoming more and more hostile towards Christians. Our brothers and sisters in China need your prayers today. Churches are being demolished and pastors are imprisoned. This is a severe problem that needs our continued prayers.

## November 24 – Abidjan, Ivory Coast (Côte d'Ivoire)

Our pastors in Abidjan are attending their Phase A training today. These pastors really caught the Harvesters vision and are making an impact in their country. Pray that they will plant a church in every community and really build God's Kingdom in Ivory Coast.

## November 25 – Meru, Kenya

Our pastors in Meru really have their work cut out for them. Meru is a drug-stricken county in Kenya where the drug, Khat, is being cultivated and used freely. Our pastors are completing their Phase A training over the next couple of days. Pray that they will reach the lost souls in their communities with the Gospel.

## November 26 – India

Our pastors and congregation members in India face terrible persecution. They risk their lives on a daily basis by sharing the Gospel, leading lost souls to Christ and making disciples for Jesus. Our brothers and sisters in India are really obedient in living out the Great Commission. Let us intercede for them today.

## November 27 – Bouaké, Ivory Coast (Côte d'Ivoire)

We have a big group of pastors gathering in Bouaké for a Kick-Off today. In the city of Bouaké, the majority of places to worship are mosques. The Bouaké region has a great need for the Gospel! Pray with us that our Harvesters pastors will reach these lost souls and share the Truth with them

## November 28 – Syria

Turkish troops have recently attacked innocent Syrian civilians. The worst part is that the civil war in Syria has been carrying on far too long – more than 400,000 innocent people have died, including children. Pray for this nation today. Only the Truth will set them free.

November 29 – United Kingdom(UK)

Harvesters is presenting a free-of-charge Disciple Makers course all across the globe. This course focuses on church growth.

We recently presented this course in the UK. Pray with us for church growth and revival. Church attendance in the UK is at an all-time low. The Church in the UK needs our urgent prayers.

November 30 – Daloa, Ivory Coast (Côte d'Ivoire)

Harvesters has a Kick-Off in Daloa today. Daloa is the third largest city in Ivory Coast. There are 34 villages close by that our pastors can reach with the Gospel. Pray that our pastors will be motivated to go out and share Christ with all the unreached individuals in the Daloa region.

December 1 – Malaysia

The official religion of this beautiful nation is Islam. More than 19 million people will be lost forever unless the Good News is shared with them. Pray with us that the doors will be wide open for us to reach the lost with the Gospel in this nation.

December 2 – Australia

More than 30% of the Australian population are atheists and believe that they do not need God. This is one of the dangers in our modern society – more and more people feel that they can live without God. Pray with us that the Holy Spirit will work in the hearts of those who have grown cold towards the Gospel.

December 3 – South Africa

We have several church streams in South Africa and the majority of South Africans claim to be Christians. However, the crime rate has escalated immensely--especially violent crime against women and children.. Someone who knows Jesus Christ will not take someone else's life or hurt another individual. Our work in South Africa is far from done.

December 4 – Ethiopia

We had a vision-sharing meeting in Adama recently. 100 Oromo pastors attended the event. Everyone's prayers are of great importance for this church stream to succeed. These pastors can reach many communities who are unreached and in dire need of the Gospel.

December 5 – Malawi

Malawi is the first country where Harvesters planted churches, trained pastors and handed out Bibles. Next year it will be 20 years since we planted the first church in this precious country. Today we have more than 16,000 churches in Malawi. Pray with us that these church streams will continue to grow and that more and more countries will follow their example.

December 6 – Amazon

More than 10,000 villages in the Amazon have no access to a church or even a Christian living in the village. Harvesters is training pastors in the Amazon to go out and reach the lost. Pray that every village in the Amazon will have a viable church.

December 7 – Vilanculos, Mozambique

Pray for the Kick-Off that is taking place in Vilanculos today. Pray for travel mercies for our team and the pastors who will be attending the training. This beautiful region is situated on

the southern coast of Mozambique. Ask the Lord to bless this training and to give our pastors the courage to reach the lost with the Gospel.

December 8 – Egypt

This Islamic nation needs our constant prayers. Our pastors are doing great work here – they are sharing the Gospel and making disciples for Christ. Ask the Lord to protect them as they go out to evangelize the lost in their communities. Pray that the door will open for Harvesters to work in the Middle East and that we will be able to bring the Truth to some of the “darkest” places on earth.

December 9 – Chile

With more than 30% of this South American country's population being unbelievers, they need our fervent prayers. Ask the Lord to open the door for Harvesters to train pastors in discipleship and evangelism in Chile. While most pastors are trained to stand in front of a congregation, they do not know how to share the Gospel in unreached communities. Pray that they will get excited about evangelism and reach out to the unreached.

December 10 – Madagascar

This country excites us! These pastors are working in difficult conditions – poverty, crime and mountainous terrains. They keep on persevering and planting churches in some of the most remote areas in their country. Pray that God will continue to strengthen them.

December 11 – Pakistan

This nation lies close to our hearts. This Islamic nation is extremely hostile towards the Gospel and needs our continued and constant prayers. Ask the Lord to stir up their hearts with a desire for the Truth. Pray that God will appear to these Islamic leaders in a supernatural way and that Harvesters will be able to train up leaders in this country.

December 12 – Lesotho

Our pastors in Lesotho have planted more than 100 churches in total. They have to travel to remote villages in the mountains and valleys. We are extremely proud of these pastors and their obedience to the Word. Continue to keep them in your prayers as they plant churches and share the Gospel despite their personal struggles.

December 13 – Zimbabwe

The drought in this African nation is absolutely horrific. Zimbabwe is heading for one of the greatest famine crises that Africa has ever seen. Pray that God will bless this country and its people. Ask the Lord to provide for our brothers and sisters in Zimbabwe as it is written in Matthew 6:26.

December 14 – Eswatini (Swaziland)

This neighboring country of South Africa has a dire need for the Harvesters church-planting model. Many people in Eswatini are still involved with ancestral worship and need to hear the true Gospel urgently. Ask the Lord to open the door for Harvesters to train church leaders in this African nation. 🙏
