## Rediscovering **Biblical Foundations** in Ghana

hana is often seen as a vibrant Christian nation.
Churches are plentiful and faith is visible. Yet, many pastors quietly acknowledge a troubling reality: biblical foundations are fading, and the focus has shifted from disciple-making to simply counting members. That's why Harvesters' work in Ghana is so crucial.

In the first half of 2025, Harvesters held training in strategic locations – including Kumasi, Obuasi, Koforidua and the capital, Accra. In each place, pastors are engaging in a four-year programme designed to train and release church leaders to plant multiplying, disciplemaking churches.

Those who participated are already seeing transformation. In Kintampo, Bismarck Asemeno Yeboah shared, "We are brought back to the foundation of the church. The church has gone wayward... now, by this glorious training, we are brought back to it." He continued, "Our focus has always been on membership... but not on the disciples."

In Koforidua, one attendee emphasised urgency and simplicity: "We don't have to wait until we get a large population before we start the church. If we are two or more, we can begin a church, whether in a room or under a tree." Rev Dr Daniel, also in Koforidua, echoed this, noting that a church can begin with just one or two in a

home. "You can teach them and disciple them," he said. "It has simplified the work for us."

From pastors in the north reaching into Togo and Burkina Faso, to leaders in Accra reimagining church growth, one theme is clear: the foundation is being restored. This is New Testament church growth – one disciple, one church at a time.

## Jeremiah - Tanzania, East Africa



I found that really encouraging."

## A New Dream:

## From Filling Seats to Planting Churches



Pev. Warren Lötter, a pastor in Parow, South Africa, recently started the Disciple Makers journey at his church – and it sparked a deep shift in vision. Once focused on growing Sunday attendance, Warren now dreams of something greater: multiplying disciples and planting churches across the northern suburbs of Cape Town. "The Lord changed my dream," he shared. "It's no longer just about filling this church with people, but about being used to plant churches – from Parow to Paarl to Stellenbosch – where disciples make disciples."

The Disciple Makers sessions challenged Warren and his church to return to the foundations of the Great Commission: sharing the Gospel, discipling others and pursuing multiplication. What began as a nine-session course became the launchpad for a bold, faith-filled dream.

With joy and faith, the church now trusts God to plant one new church by Pentecost next year. "And maybe you can pray with us that the Lord will help us to achieve that," asks Warren.
