



India: The World's Largest Mission Field

India is home to more than 1.46 billion people — almost as many as the entire continent of Africa. One in every six people on earth lives there, making it the world's largest mission field. Yet over 2,000 people groups in India remain unreached with the Gospel, and among many of them, less than 0.1% of the population knows Christ.

Harvesters is working to change this reality. Despite growing opposition and anti-conversion laws in several states, pastors continue to be trained and new church-planting Streams are opening across the nation. Two of Harvesters' Hot Zones — areas where the potential for rapid church planting is significant — are in India.

In one northwestern Stream, forty Harvesters-trained leaders are ministering among twenty distinct unreached people groups. Six new training Streams have been launched in recent months, with plans for twenty-three this year.

A powerful moment during our last visit was travelling through a northern city, marked by a spiritual darkness that we felt heavily in our hearts, to a beloved pastor's home. As we approached, we heard faint voices singing 'Light of the World' — a precious reminder that the Lord brings hope into dark places.

Many in this beautiful nation are lost; trapped worshipping dead gods. Each of them is important to God. Every pastor trained and every church planted represents one more community reached with the hope of Jesus. As Harvesters continues to expand in India's most spiritually dark and densely populated areas, the light of the Gospel is breaking through. ☑



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God's Children Overcoming Fear and Apathy in Europe

“For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.”

– 2 Timothy 1:7

On a sunny day in Bornholm, Denmark, Bent was sitting by a fountain, warming his face in the sun and praying. He was just about to leave when two young men approached and asked, “Is there room here; are you leaving?” It had taken thirteen years for Bent to obey God’s call. This was the moment he had been waiting for. “Sit here,” he said, making room for them.



Bent’s own timidity, the power of the Holy Spirit took over.

THE SPIRIT LEADS US

When the men asked him what he was doing, Bent answered fearlessly: “I am praying.” From there a conversation opened, and he told them about Jesus. He laid his hands on them and prayed that they would not find peace until they accepted Jesus as their Saviour.

THE GREAT COMMISSION CHALLENGES AND INSPIRES

Throughout Europe, many Christians like Bent are caught in the chains of passivity and fear. The influence and size of the church is declining and the majority of those who still consider themselves Christians have become lukewarm and apathetic to the Great Commission. In Denmark only 10% of the population are church-goers, opposed to 55% of the population that is classified as non-practicing Christians*. But God has called Harvesters and faithful partners to help reignite the flame of faith in Denmark and the rest of Europe.

After attending Harvesters’ Disciple Makers teachings at his church, Bent was both challenged and inspired. A long time ago God had placed a vision in his heart to pray, get on a train and share the Gospel with whomever God sent to sit next to him. Now, thirteen years later, Bent was finally ready to obey this call.

He asked his wife to pray for him, went out and waited by a fountain in town. When two men sat down next to him, he was nervous. He believed that sharing his story and the Gospel with them would never work. But, in spite of

“I’m so happy,” Bent reflected. “I received this push to share the best message ever with others.” The excuses he made in the past – the weather is too bad, it’s too hot, too cold, too windy – disappeared in the face of faithful prayer and fearless obedience.

Just as the Spirit transformed Bent’s faith, Christians all over Europe are being transformed in the same manner. Fear is being replaced by boldness, timidity by determination and passivity by action. Though statistics may suggest decline, Christ is alive – and His Kingdom remains sovereign!

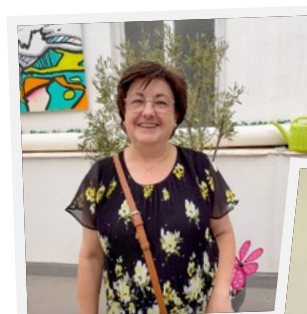

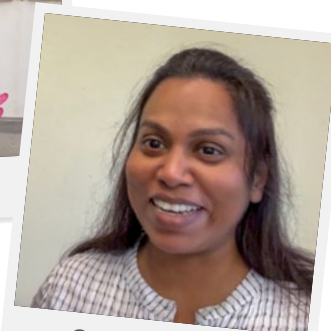
TRANSFORMATION THROUGHOUT EUROPE

Over in Málaga, Spain, Lourdes attended Harvesters' Disciple Makers training too. She explained: "The Gospel is simple, just as Jesus preached it, for humble, ordinary people. 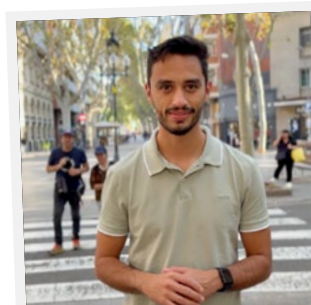
