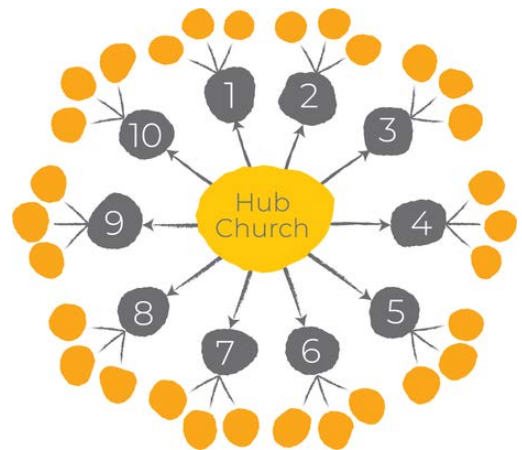
The HUB church multiplication method :

Local church-based network: A HUB is a regional church led by a trusted indigenous pastor that anchors training and multiplication in each locality.

Training distribution point: The HUB receives and distributes the curriculum and tools (often via SD cards and printed materials) to Student Pastors in surrounding areas.

Ongoing coaching & accountability: HUB leaders mentor Student Pastors, monitor progress, and provide practical support as students train while actively planting churches, becoming a multiplication engine.

Contextual, scalable, and resilient: Our model adapts to local regions and scales through relationships rather than buildings or centralized infrastructure.



1. **Evangelism** - Training Student Pastors in Biblical evangelism.
2. **Church Planting** - Equipping Student Pastors to plant one healthy, self-replicating church each year of training.
3. **Discipleship** - Intentional discipleship of new believers that helps them mature in the Faith, and actively disciple others.
4. **Identify a Leader** - Identify and train emerging indigenous leaders from within the local church to lead the next church plant and disciple others.
5. **Train the Leader** - Provide free, accessible pastoral training through a comprehensive four-year curriculum.
6. **Replication** - Equip pastors to plant self-replicating churches that multiply through evangelism, discipleship, and ongoing leadership development.

Our Partners

We partner with like-minded organizations who share our vision to help fulfill the Great Commission. We have ongoing, joint global efforts with One Hope, Faith Comes by Hearing, BEE World, Biblica, The Finishing Fund, and others. Currently we are the top recipient and global distributor of Bibles from Biblica. This exciting collaboration is named the “First Church, First Bible” project.

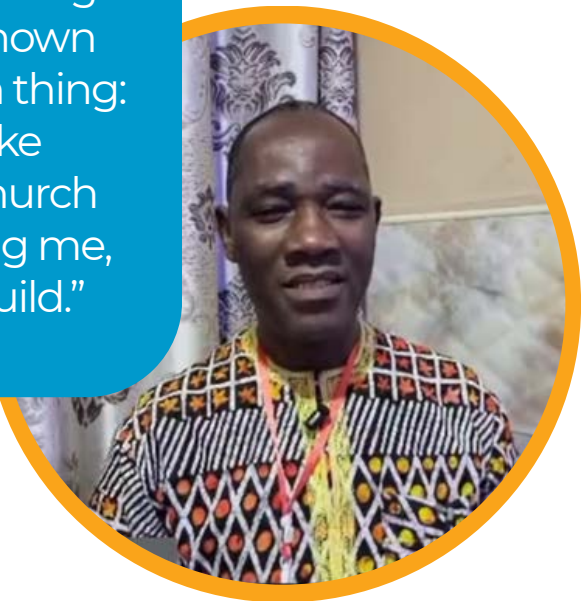




Mission Impact: Nigerian Pastors Empowered

Mission Impact: Equipping Pastors in Ghana



Pastor Edmond, who travelled 80 km (50 miles) to Accra, testified that the material is “an answer to a heart cry.. Like a mustard seed given to our hands.”

Reverend Moses, a veteran pastor of 36 years who has already planted seven churches, described Harvesters’ methodology as “an eye-opener,” especially around discipleship. He’s already recruiting young pastors to embrace this vision.





Mission Impact: Transformation in Guatemala



“Harvesters taught me in the training how to evangelize, how to disciple, how to plant churches, how to multiply, and how to care for the planted churches. 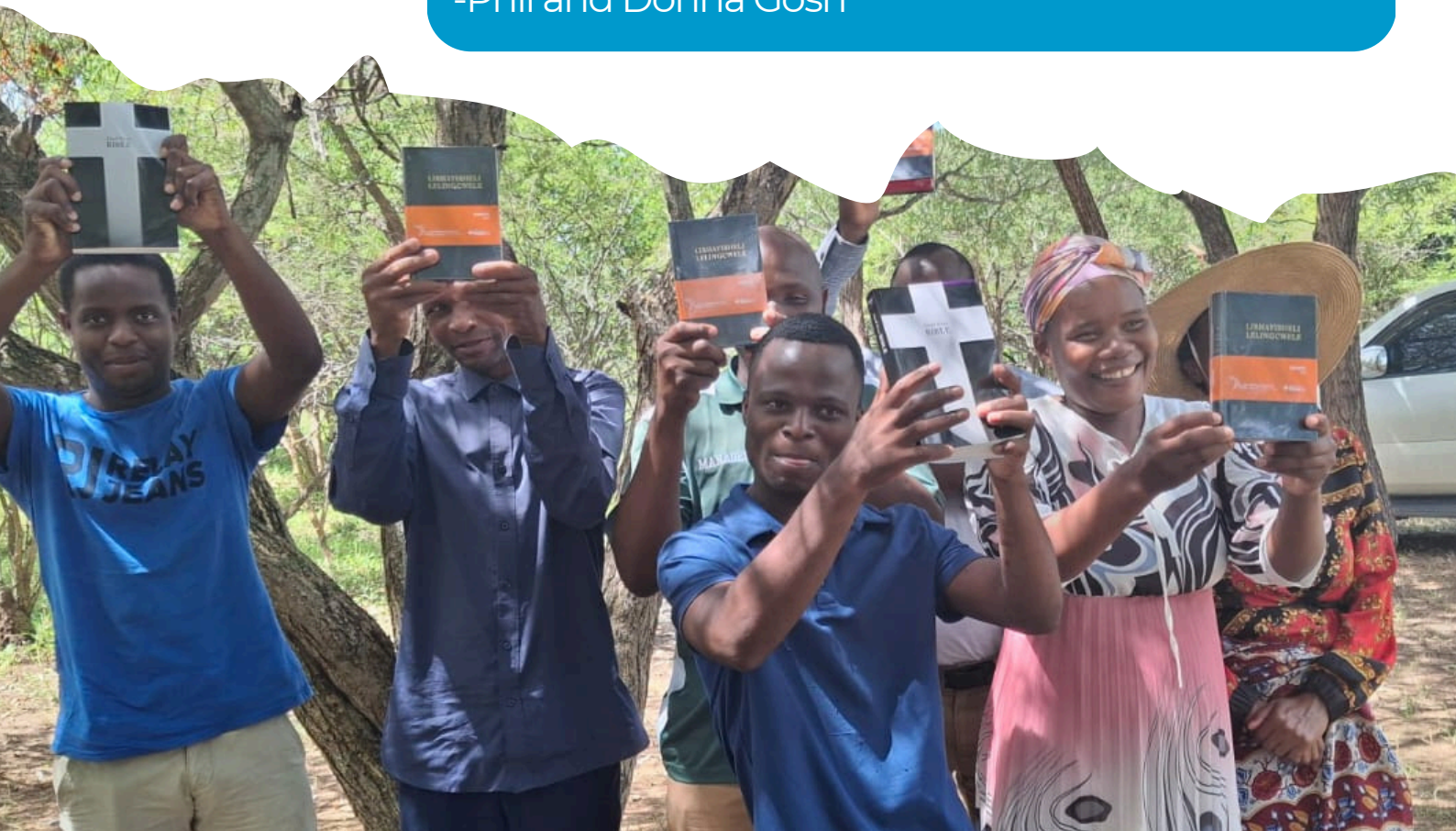

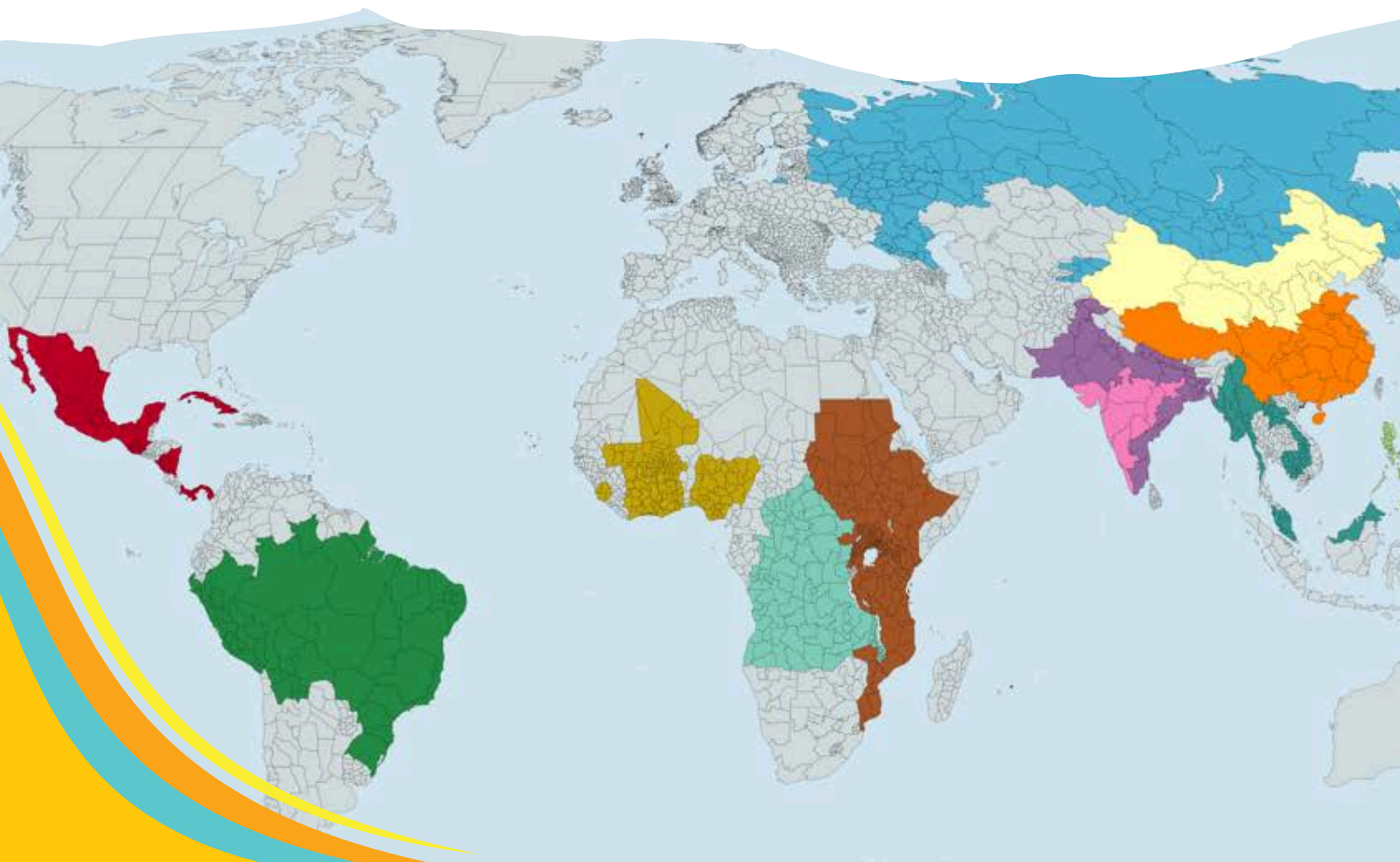

2026 Vision

In 2026, Harvesters Ministries will advance with focused urgency—strengthening momentum across 105 countries while concentrating on 12 strategic *Hot Zones* where urgency, opportunity, and need converge. Each *Hot Zone* represents the potential to see up to 75,000 churches planted over the next 5–8 years, and this year we are implementing indigenous leadership teams in each nation to oversee and steward this exponential growth.

The Importance of Training Pastors by Founder, Steven Loots



Multiplication movements that do not prioritize formal training for pastors often see high attrition rates due to the lack of theological and leadership foundations. Without adequate training, leaders may lack the doctrinal understanding and pastoral skills needed to guide their congregations effectively. This can lead to theological errors, conflict, and eventual burnout, as leaders feel unprepared to address the complex challenges that arise in ministry. They and their churches are vulnerable to cults and false teaching.

In addition to theological gaps, untrained pastors often experience emotional and psychological burnout. Ministry can be demanding, and without the necessary tools for handling stress, conflict, and emotional pressures, many pastors in rapid multiplication movements quickly become overwhelmed. Moreover, the absence of ongoing support structures such as mentorship and accountability leaves these pastors isolated, increasing the likelihood of attrition when they face difficulties in their ministry context.

Harvesters has committed to training a pastor for every church it plants. Using a four-year curriculum that equips local indigenous leaders while they serve in their local churches allows for rapid multiplication of churches in areas with limited resources, making it possible to reach more unreached people with the gospel while ensuring that local pastors are well-prepared to lead and disciple their communities.
